




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"Blank Slate" redesign of SEPTA's fixedroute bus network

### Why Now?

- SEPTA Forward emphasizes a more fully integrated network
- SEPTA has never looked at its network comprehensively before
- Transfer penalty eliminated in 2020
- Between 2013 & 2019 ridership dropped 13% but operating costs went up 10% while service got slower and less reliable
- Post covid ridership is down 30-40%





### SEPTA's Draft Bus Network: Strategic Approach - City





### **Understanding the MAX Series**

- The Bus Revolution uses the "MAX series" to talk about bus routes.
- MAX means the <u>maximum</u> time between buses. For example, a 10 MAX route will arrive at least every 10 minutes.
- All bus routes are described as:
  - 10 MAX l
    - Frequent Bus Service
  - 30 MAX

- 15 MAX


- 60 MAX



Bus Revolution defines a "frequent" bus route as one that operates every 15 minutes or better.


#### Changes in North Philly: 11 north-south routes

- 10 MAX service on 4 north-south routes:
  - 512 (7, 48, 49): 27<sup>th</sup>/Allegheny Penn's Landing via Market Street
  - 514 (17/33): 22<sup>nd</sup>/Venango -19<sup>th</sup>/Moyamensing in S. Philly
  - 546 (23): Chestnut Hill 11<sup>th</sup>/Market
  - 518 (47/47M): 5<sup>th</sup>/Godfrey Oregon/3<sup>rd</sup>
- 15 MAX service on 3 north-south routes:
  - 510 (32, 49): Ivy Ridge Station –
     33<sup>rd</sup>/Tasker in Grays Ferry via U. City
  - 520 (57): Fern Rock TC York Dauphin Station
  - 550 (57): Spring Garden Station Oregon/3<sup>rd</sup>




